Second Annual Chattanooga Challenge 9-Ball Round Robin Singles Tournament

NOTE: The Chattanooga Billiard Club is a designated smoking venue. As such, Tennessee state law prohibits entry to anyone under the age of 21. However, the building is equipped with a state-of-the-art air filtration system and high capacity "smoke eaters" to better serve their patrons.

Times:

- Doors open for registration and practice at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday. Start time is Noon.
- Doors open at 1:00 p.m. on Sunday. Remaining tournament matches and the Second-Chance Tournament will begin at 1:30 p.m.

Format:

- Open Division only - No Handicap
- Round Robin matches will be played in groups of 8-10 players.
- Players in Round Robin groups will be equally distributed based on leagues represented.
- Matches will be a race to 4, with standings based on total games won.
- A coin flip will determine the player to break first. Players will alternate breaks thereafter.
- After completion of the Round Robin matches, the field will be cut to the top 25%, based on total points won, who will return on Sunday to play another set of Round Robin matches.
- Games won on Saturday will not carry over to Sunday. All players in finals will start at zero.

Eligibility: All current ACS members are eligible, as well as anyone who played at least eight (8) weeks in a sanctioned ACS league between June 1, 2009 and May 31, 2010. Additionally, all players who compete in any in-house league at the Chattanooga Billiard Club are eligible.

Equipment: (14) 8-ft Brunswick Gold Crown IV tables are designated for the tournament. The tables are covered with Simonis cloth and red dot cue balls will be used.

Entry Fee: \$30.00 per person, which includes a \$5.00 registration fee.

Prize Fund: ACS Georgia will add \$300 to the prize and the Chattanooga Billiard Club will donate all table time until 8:30 p.m. Approximately 1 place will be paid for every 4 entries. Based on a 32-player field, payouts would be: 1-\$500, 2-\$250, 3-\$120, 4-\$70, 5&6-\$50, 7&8-\$30. We expect the field to be between 32 and 40 players. The prize fund payout will be changed proportionally based on the number of entries. A trophy will be awarded to the winner.

Second-Chance Tournament:

A Second-Chance Tournament will be held on Sunday for any players eliminated from the tournament on Saturday. The format will be 9-Ball Singles with races to 4. The entry fee will be \$25, all going to the prize fund. Approximately 1 place will be paid for every 4 entries.
