TOURNAMENT INFORMATION SHEET

Dates: Saturday and Sunday, March 27-28, 2010

NOTE: Mazzy's Sports Bar & Grill is a designated smoking venue. As such, Georgia state law prohibits entry to anyone under the age of 21.

Times:

- Doors open for registration and practice at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday. Start time is noon.
- Doors open at noon. on Sunday. Remaining tournament matches and the Second-Chance Tournament will begin at noon.

Format:

- 3-Man Team Event - Open Division only - No Handicap
- Double-Elimination
- 8-Ball / 9-Ball Combination (Similar to U.S. Amateur and APA Masters format)
- Players will lag to begin match.
- The winner of the lag chooses the game to start (8-Ball or 9-Ball) OR to take the first break.
- The loser of the lag has the choice not opted for by the winner of the lag.
- If 9-Ball is chosen as the game to start, all games of 9-Ball are played, followed by as many games of 8-Ball as necessary to complete the match, or vice versa.
- Matches will be a race to 5 on the winners' side and a race to 4 on the losers' side.
(Note: If 9-Ball is chosen as the starting game, the match could end before playing 8-Ball.)
- The winner of each game will have the break in the following game.

Eligibility: Participants must be ACS members and have played a minimum of four full matches over a minimum of four weeks during a sanctioned session in an ACS league since June 1, 2009. Teams must be composed of at least two members from the same local team plus one from the same league operator system.

Equipment: (11) 8-ft Olhausen tables are designated for the tournament. Red dot cue balls will be used.

Entry Fee: \$100 per team, includes \$10 registration fee.

Prize Fund: There will be \$200 added to the prize fund and the Mazzy's Sports Bar & Grill will donate all table time. Approximately 1 place will be paid for every 4 entries. Based on a 16-team field, 1st Place would pay \$700, 2nd \$460, 3rd \$300, 4th \$180. We expect the field to be between 12 and 16 teams. The prize fund payout will change proportionally based on the entries.

Second-Chance Tournament:

A Second-Chance Tournament will be held on Sunday at noon for any ACS members not still playing in the remaining matches of the Masters Team Tournament. The format will be 9-Ball Singles with races to 5 on the winners' side and races to 4 on the losers' side. The entry fee is \$25, all going to the prize fund. Approximately 1 place will be paid for every 4 entries.

Lodging: There are a number of hotels located conveniently to the Mazzy's Sports Bar & Grill. See the Roswell Hotel Information sheet for details.
